2 Praise God that some of our containers of humanitarian aid goods for the hurting people of Ukraine have cleared customs! Now, our in-country team is bringing these life-saving goods to those in need.

3 Please pray that God would continue working in the hearts of the thousands of children and youth who heard the Good News of Jesus during this year's summer Bible camps.

4 Pray for our SWW coordinators from Armenia, Belarus, Moldova, Russia, and Ukraine, who met in August and are now leading SWW sessions and other ministry events.

5 Pray for our SWW leaders in Chechnya, Russia as they faithfully share the gospel in the midst of escalating religious persecution.

6 Please pray for the many Christian teachers in Ukraine who received training through the International Alliance for the Development of Christian Education (IADCE) and are now incorporating biblical themes into their lessons.

7 Pray for our two new SWW groups in Armenia. Many people in this country are nominal Christians, but very few of them have a personal relationship with Jesus.

8 Pray for our SWW leaders in Moldova as they share the hope of the gospel with their hurting neighbors, many of whom are living in poverty.

9 Continue praying for our ministry team and SWW leaders in Russia's North Caucasus, where radical Islam is growing and religious persecution is escalating rapidly.

10 Please pray for Ray and Cindy Le Clair, our missionaries in Ukraine, as Ray recovers from rotator cuff surgery while continuing to serve with the IADCE.

11 Praise God for the new SWW center that we

opened in partnership with *Living Israel* in Rishon LeZion, Israel!

12 Pray for the young people who are attending the *Don't Waste Your Life Youth Conference* in Kyiv, Ukraine on September 12-13. We are leading a Next Generation Professional Leaders Initiative (NGPLI) training seminar during this conference.

13 Pray for our SWW leaders and the other young people from Belarus, Moldova, Russia, and Ukraine who are participating in a Baptist youth conference in Kyiv, Ukraine on September 12-14.

14 Please pray for an NGPLI training seminar that we are leading during a conference for charismatic churches in Ukraine on September 13-14.

15 Today, thousands of people in Ukraine are participating in the annual Thanksgiving Day celebration in Kyiv. Please pray for our SWW leaders who are distributing Scripture and sharing the gospel with those they meet during the festivities.

16 Pray for SWW leaders in Perm, Russia as they encourage local churches to get involved in reaching their community for Christ.

17 Pray that the Russian translation of the *Faith and Science* teaching website for Christian teachers in Ukraine would be ready in time for the IADCE training in October.

18 Continue praying for our brothers and sisters in Central Asia as they faithfully share the gospel in the midst of intensifying persecution.

19 Praise God for a new SWW group in St. Petersburg, Russia! Please pray that God would use this ministry to touch the hearts of the city's youth.

20 Pray for our SWW leaders in Israel who are sharing the Good News of the Messiah with God's chosen people in the Holy Land.

21 Please pray for our ministry team in Omsk, Russia as they hope to start recording evangelistic videos on YouTube to reach Siberian Tatars with the gospel.

22 Continue praying that God would bring an end to the ongoing conflict in eastern Ukraine so that this hurting nation can start to heal and rebuild.

23 Praise God for Roman, our SWW coordinator

in St. Petersburg, Russia! He and his wife are expecting a baby.

24 Pray for our SWW leaders in Armenia and Azerbaijan, where the conflict over the Nagorno-Karabakh region continues to cause division between the two nations.

25 Please pray for a family club that our SWW leaders in Omsk, Russia are launching in order to reach non-Christians for Christ.

26 Pray for young Christian professionals all across Eurasia who are using their NGPLI training to share the gospel in their workplaces and spheres of influence.

27 Pray for Konstantin, our SWW coordinator in Omsk, Russia, and his family. They recently opened a café, where they host evangelistic events.

28 Many of our SWW leaders in Central Asia come from strict Muslim families, so please pray that God would comfort them in the midst of rejection and persecution.

29 Pray for our SWW leaders in Omsk, Russia, as they are planning to start a club for the disabled in their community.
