2 Continue praying that our containers of humanitarian aid for those in need in Ukraine would clear customs as quickly as possible.

3 Pray for a Next Generation Professional Leaders Initiative (NGPLI) conference that we are hosting (either in person or via livestream) in St. Petersburg, Russia tomorrow.

4 Praise God that Living Israel School Without Walls (SWW) is now operating in 20 different cities in Israel!

5 Please pray for Church Without Walls (CWW) in Pinsk, Belarus as they host a weeklong ministry event to reach young people with the gospel.

6 Pray for our ministry leaders in Moldova, as the coronavirus outbreak forced them to postpone a large-scale conference focused on spiritual renewal.

7 Pray for Anatoliy, our SWW coordination in Ulyanovsk, Russia, as his team is making plans to build a new church where they can host SWW events.

8 Please pray for SWW leaders in Israel as they provide clothing, food, haircuts, and other services for the homeless community throughout their nation.

9 Continue praying that God would bring an end to the ongoing conflict in Ukraine's eastern regions.

10 Pray for SWW leaders throughout Eurasia as they host special evangelistic events during the week of Easter.

11 Please pray for SWW leaders in Perm, Russia as they continue to expand their ministry efforts in this remote region.

12 Pray for Igor, our SWW coordinator at Missionary Church in Gomel, Belarus, as he balances his ministry and family responsibilities.

13 Please continue praying for our brothers and

sisters throughout Central Asia as they stand firm in faith amid escalating religious persecution.

16 Pray for SWW leaders in Israel as they share the healing hope of Jesus with Holocaust survivors in their communities.

17 Please pray for our Scripture distribution efforts in Ukraine and all across Eurasia, and that God would use His Word to comfort those who are suffering.

18 Pray for Missionary Church in Gomel, Belarus as they lead 12 young people, most of whom are not believers, on an evangelistic trip to the Carpathian Mountains.

19 Pray for our SWW coordinators and teachers in Russia's North Caucasus as they host SWW sessions in two new regions: Pyatigorsk and Karachayevo-Cherkessia.

20 Please pray for our SWW leaders in Israel as they share the freeing love of Christ with alcoholics and drug addicts at the Living Israel rehabilitation center.

21 Praise God for the growing small group ministry at CWW in Pinsk, Belarus!

22 Pray for SWW leaders in Eurasia's most remote regions, including Arctic Siberia, Mongolia, and Central Asia.

23 Please pray that SWW leaders in Ulyanovsk, Russia would continue growing in faith and serving as witnesses for Christ in their city.

24 Pray for a SWW session that is taking place tomorrow at Missionary Church in Gomel, Belarus.

25 Pray that God would transform the hearts of those impacted by the ministry efforts of SWW leaders in Israel and would use them to grow His Kingdom in the Holy Land.

26 Please pray for Mission Eurasia's new ministry team in Russia's North Caucasus, where we hope to expand our many evangelistic efforts.

27 Pray that God would provide new leaders for the home groups launched by Missionary Church in Gomel, Belarus.

28 The leaders of Living Israel SWW would like to open another rehabilitation center in Israel, so

please pray that God would provide the resources needed for this project.

29 Praise God for the many young people who have put their faith in Jesus at Hope Church in Russia's North Caucasus! Ten of these young people are now preparing for baptism.
