While in rehab, Jesus radically transformed Alexey's life.



10 Pray for our team as we will be hosting a "Family as Mission" conference today in Moldova.

11 There are 25 regions in Uliastai, Mongolia, and no churches in 12 of them, leaders there say. Please pray for our team in the country, that the ministry there will continue to grow, and that churches will soon be planted throughout this area.

12 Pray for the SWW ministry to the deaf in

Kazakhstan and that God would protect them from being persecuted by authorities for their faith.

13 Pray for the youth ministry at God's Family Church in Minsk, Belarus. Pray that the work there would be guided by the Holy Spirit and that more young lives would be transformed for Christ.

14 Pray for those who are sick with the coronavirus at Light to the World Church in Grodno, Belarus. Pray that the recent Christmas events would be used for spiritual renewal for children and all involved in this new year.
