After a Mission Eurasia Next Generation Professional Leaders Initiative (NGPLI) training event in Uzbekistan, Alisher, a young businessman, shared his story, while holding his son in his arms, and discussed how God is calling him to balance his time better.

"It was important for me to learn that my work is also my ministry, and that God wants me to serve, not only in my business, but also in my own family," said Alisher, who was born into a Muslim family and whose uncle taught in a mosque.


"I realized that it was the truth I had been looking for my entire life," he said. After attending a NGPLI event, Alisher signed up for our School Without Walls (SWW) leadership development program. He completed the training and prayed that God would provide him with a job through which he could share the Good News with Muslims.

"The Lord perfectly answered my prayers, and now I own a travel business, through which I book tours, provide medical insurance, make car rentals, and book flights for people traveling [in Eurasia]." Many clients share their struggles and prayer requests with Alisher's team, which opens the door for ministry.
